**Veteran cars and motorcycles
manufactured before 1st January 1919.**

The Rally celebrates 75 years of the Sporting Car Club of S.A. with its Veteran Car Section. This began the veteran vehicle movement in Australia in 1934.

Before wine became a major commodity Naracoorte and the surrounding districts were sheep country. Mustering took place with the assistance of cut down motor cars known as buckboards.

Naracoorte is known for its world heritage conservation park and has 26 large caves containing complete fossils which are 500,000 years old.

The wine industry has been established in this area for some time with brand names such as Coonawarra, Padthaway, Wrattenbully, etc not forgetting Naracoorte. Together they are known as the Limestone Coast wine region.

The terrain of the area is undulating which means there are no BIG hills although rally routes are still being checked. It is expected that routes will be reasonable and not too much off the beaten track. The South East is well known for its culinary skills and so your well-being will be looked after with morning teas and lunches.

How to enter

The cost per entry is \$100. There is an additional charge for passengers and that will be on the entry form.
